Explanation

An International Doctoral Colloquium is scheduled for October 5/6, 2022 at the Faculty of Theology of Georg-August-Universität Göttingen. Doctoral students from different disciplines are invited to present their dissertation projects to a circle of international researchers working on related issues. Thematically, the focus is on doctoral theses that ask: What has led Orthodox churches to become ecumenically engaged? What specific contribution have they made to the ecumenical movement? What concerns have been formulated from their side? In the line of a polycentric history of Christianity, Orthodox Christianity worldwide will be considered, beyond the Eastern Orthodox Churches also the Oriental Orthodox Churches. The conference is hosted by the Chair of „Ecumenical Theology with special reference to Orthodox Christianity and its global impact in history and the present.“ The conference language will be English. Travel and accommodation expenses will be covered for the participants of the colloquium.
